## Minutes of the Video Conference dated: 14.07.2020

Hon'ble Commissioner, KVS conducted a VC with all DC's and AC's on 14.07.2020.

the Agenda points of the meeting were:-

1. Identifying the lowest performing zones regarding conduct of online teaching due to less coverage of device.

2. Information of NCERT calendars to guardians.

- 3. CCT-6 and important activities to be conducted for enhancing creative and critical thinking of students.
- 4. Preparation of competency based questions.
- 5. Online observation of classroom teaching.

## **MINUTES**

The important discussion points of the meeting are appended below:-

 The obstacles that are being faced by the Vidyalayas, which have so far displayed lowest performance regarding imparting online education, were discussed extensively during the meeting.

Hon'ble Commissioner set a target of zero left out cases of students due to non-availability of gadgets and internet. He instructed all to come out with innovative

measures for filling out the gap.

- It was further instructed that every parent/guardian should be sent Alternative Academic Calendars (primary, secondary, senior secondary) published by NCERT by the respective KVs. The copies of the same may also be uploaded in the Vidyalaya website.
- 3. Though the CCT-6 practice session got over on 14.07.2020, the attendance of students had been quite low. Therefore it has been decided that the link shall remain open till this week. All left-out students from VI to X (irrespective of whether they are PISA eligible or not) should be motivated to take the test from their home. The Vidyalayas should keep record of the number of students who would appear in the test.

In order to utilize the present no – school period, students should be given exercises online in order to enhance their skill of **READING WITH SPEED AND** 

COMPREHENSION.

All PISA eligible students should be divided among a few competent teachers of the Vidyalaya, who will mentor them for future. Thus, a mentor – mentee relationship will be developed among them which will be beneficial to hone the CCT skill of students.

Every Vidyalaya should develop a CCT corner and also a CCT helpline desk in this regard.

4. A team of Assistant Commissioners is constituted by KVS (HQ), who will work along with subject teachers for preparation/review of Competency based questions of CBSE.

5. It was unanimously decided to develop a common proforma for all regions for monitoring the online classes.

The meeting thus came to a conclusion.
