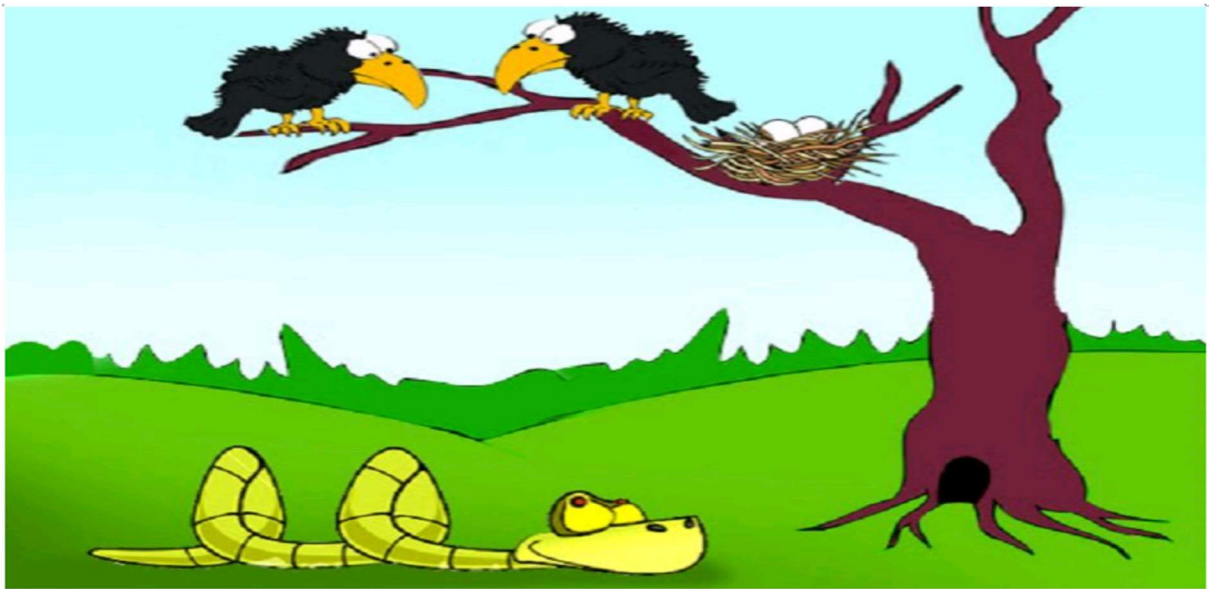

This public notice consists of a very short text that has an everyday function: to warn about the possible danger of a product to consumers and to give advice to return the product for a refund. While the formatting of the stimulus reflects the international standard for product recall notices, many students may not have seen this kind of notice. Nevertheless, the content of the warning is clearly set out and a minimum number of words is used. Lemon biscuits were chosen as the product because of their familiarity and likely appeal.

2. आपने कबीर की 'साखियाँ और सबद' पढ़े। कबीर द्वारा रचित 10 साखियाँ (दोहे) और 2 सबद (पदों) का संग्रह करते हुए उनका भावार्थ लिखिए जो आपकी पाठ्यपुस्तक में नहीं आए हों।
